Improve Your Urologic Health

Here are some healthy living tips you can use to improve your urologic health:

- Drink lots of water to prevent kidney stones and your risk of UTIs.
- Try to use the restroom every 3-4 hours to lower your chance of UTIs and leakage.
- Keep a healthy weight to lower your risk of kidney stones, leakage, and overactive bladder.
- Exercise.
- Don't smoke. Smoking increases your risk of bladder cancer, kidney cancer, erectile dysfunction, painful bladder syndrome, and urine leakage.
- Maintain healthy blood pressure, blood sugar, and cholesterol levels to reduce your risk of kidney disease.
- Reduce stress. Finding healthy ways to stress less can lower blood pressure, which may improve erectile function.

Who Should Visit a Urologist?

A urologist specializes in diagnosing and treating diseases of the male and female urinary system and the male reproductive system. You should visit a urologist if you experience any of these symptoms or conditions:

- Pain or discomfort during urination
- Blood in your urine or semen
- Kidney disorders or stones
- Enlarged or inflamed prostate
- Incontinence
- Sexual dysfunction, such as erectile dysfunction or infertility
- Frequent or recurring urinary tract infections
- Pelvic floor dysfunction and prolapse
- Cancer (prostate, bladder, or kidney)
- Bladder infections
- STD/STIs
- Male hormone problems, like low testosterone

Treatment and Continued Care

NMC Health Urology Specialists offers a range of treatment options, including surgery and minimally invasive procedures.

- Vasectomy
- Cystoscopy, or urinary endoscopy
- Newborn circumcisions
- Prostate biopsies and removals
- Surgical removal of bladder tumor
- Kidney removal
- Adrenal gland removal
- Bladder slings
- Penile implants
- Laser kidney stone fragmentation/dusting
- Removal of kidney stones
- Hydrocelectomy, or the removal of hydrocele, a fluid built up near the testicles
- Repair of pelvic organ prolapse
