HARVEY COUNTY 2023 CHNA

The objective of the Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) is to study the health needs of the community so the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) goals and strategies are tailored to our community. It is done by several partners and volunteers to achieve a healthier county.

METHODOLOGY

This report was developed through collaboration with several local partners, following a comprehensive, systematic process that involved data collection and analysis. The Community Health Needs Assessment evidence-based (CHNA) utilized practices examined both primary and secondary data sources. Primary data included a county-wide survey, seven focus groups conducted throughout the county, including one of them in Spanish, as well as an analysis of Harvey County 911 calls. Secondary data were obtained from organizations such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Kansas Department of Health & Environment (KDHE), and the Kansas Department of Labor (KDOL).

After the data were collected, a larger team comprised of professionals and community members with diverse backgrounds and expertise reviewed the information. They identified health priorities that have a significant impact on the county residents' well-being and that are feasible to be addressed within the next three years. Subsequently, members of this team crafted the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP). This project aims to address the CHNA methodically, using parameters from Healthy People 2030 goals.

AT A GLANCE

The CHNA used primary and secondary data to understand key barriers for overall health improvement in Harvey County.

PURPOSE

The findings were used to create a three-year plan to improve the lives of the county residents.

Public input was welcome on all stages of the process.
